

TRAILS ON THE BENACANTIL

MOUNT BENACANTIL is one of the most emblematic green areas in the municipality of Alicante. Here we can find flora and fauna elements which are worth knowing and conserving.

The Santa Bárbara Castle, built during the 8th and 9th centuries, and modified throughout the history of the city, interrelating and influencing its development, stands out in this area.

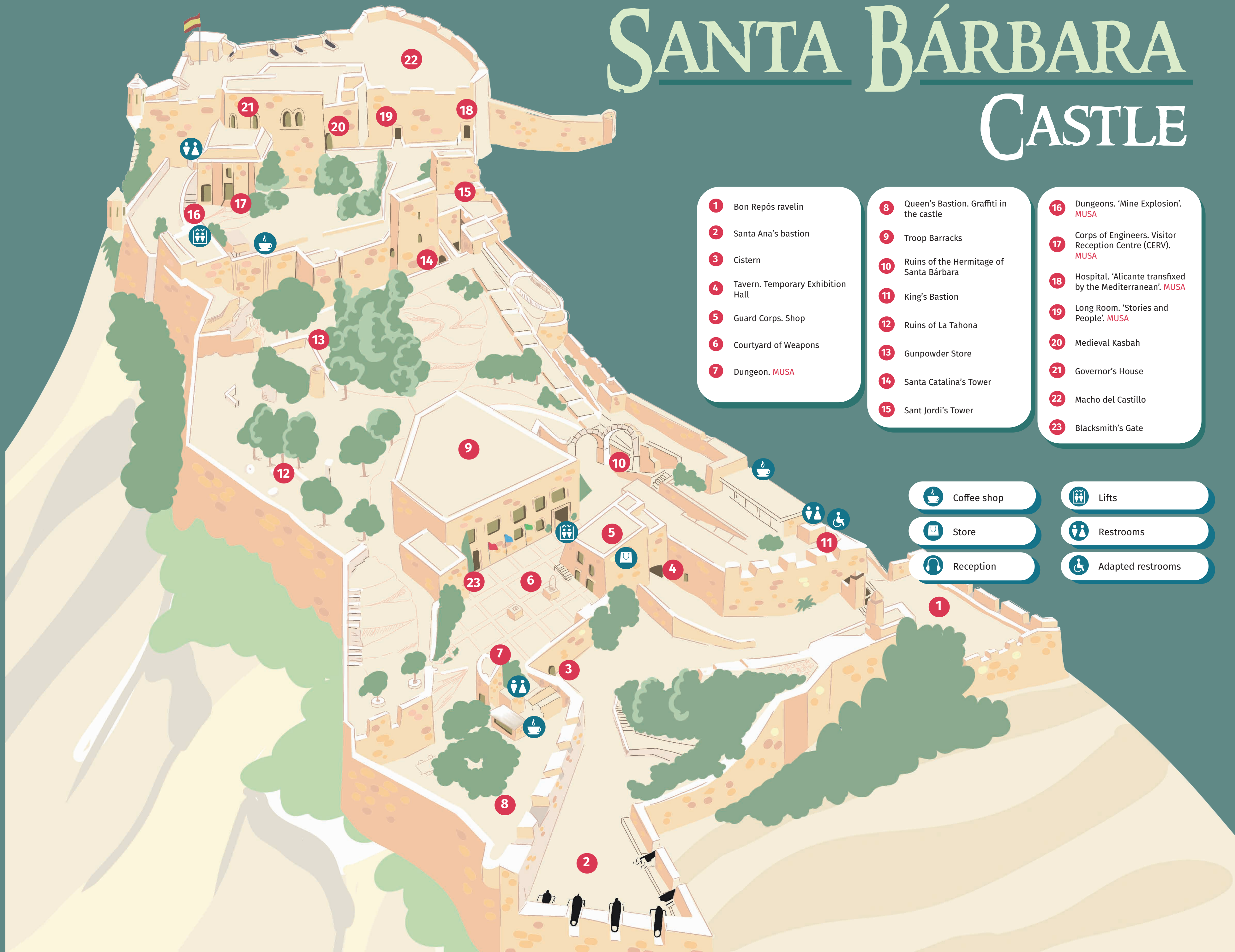
The zone of the hill that has been chosen to develop all the different routes is the north-northeast slope as it is the most accessible and most interesting area from an environmental point of view.

All the routes set off from the same point: the Environmental Education Centre (CEA) on Mount Benacantil, and all of them show the most important features of the area through which they pass, with the most complete being Itinerary 1 or Red.
